

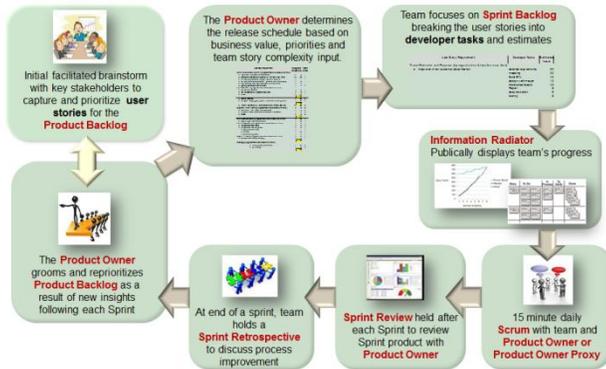

The very nature of BI requires an adaptable approach to these constantly emerging and evolving business demands.

Organization of the Course:

Examples, illustrations, and case studies are used to ensure that students fully understand the concepts being taught. The course includes lecture, discussion, hands on exercises and group case studies that walk the student through the process of agile and lean development. Focus is on a Program approach to:

- **Agile and Lean Overview**
The tools and techniques of Agile and Lean approaches with emphasis on the Agile Manifesto and the Twelve Principles of Agile.
- **Agile Business Intelligence (BI)**
The tools and techniques of Agile and Self-Service BI. With emphasis on Agile Scrum delivery of measurable business value.
- **Agile Data Management (DM)**
The tools and techniques of the Agile DM Framework with emphasis on Kanban "lean" principles for "just-in-time" modeling; data governance, data quality and data architecture for the continuous flow of quality data in support of "downstream" activities such as DW, SOA and data sharing.
- **Agile Data Warehousing (DW)**
The tools and techniques of Agile DW with emphasis on the role of data integration, ETL, alerts, the operational data store and data marts in the DW environment.
- **Agile and Culture**
The tools and techniques of agile adoption and maturity. With emphasis on the process of cultural change and transition as critical success factors.
